In order to ensure you have a place, your **forms should be returned to the Madressa, next Sunday 11th May**.

Would **ALL parents** please ensure that their children are dropped off at the centre **no later than 7:30am**, as we plan to **leave the Centre at 8:00am**, sharp.

7:30 am	Children, volunteers and teachers arrive at Zainabiya Centre
7:45-8:00 am	Coaches arrive (/ children seated in coach)
7:55 am	Group Leader briefings - outside coaches, prior to departure
8:00 am	Coaches depart from Zainabiya Centre promptly
10:00 am	Arrival at Drayton Manor. Groups formed. Leaders take groups into park
1:00 pm	Group leaders return to <u>agreed meeting point</u> for Salah (in Wudhu) & lunch
2:15 pm	Group Leaders take their groups back into Drayton Manor
4:45 pm	Return to coach
5:00 pm	Coaches depart promptly from Drayton Manor
7:00-7:30pm	Coaches arrive promptly at Zainabiya Centre

We will be observing hijab throughout this event.

Children will be allocated to a group by age and since this is a Madressa outing, parents will also be allocated to one of these groups.
